

Alimos Marina Base Information

About the Marina

Alimos Marina is one of the largest marinas in Greece with more than 1000 permanent positions. The Marina is located South West of Athens 15 Km from the city center, 8 Km South of Piraeus port and 30 km from El. Venizelos International Airport. It is served by a dense transportation network of Trams, Buses and Taxis, with stations 500 meters from the Marina.

Arrival Information:

When arriving please come to Yacht Charter Village, our office number is A53. There our customer service representative will assist you with all information needed regarding check in, embarkation, provisioning. You can also drop off your bags.

We recommend you arrive to the marina earlier than the embarkation time with all the necessary documentation (sailing licenses) so that we can complete all the paperwork needed to get permission to sail. A few days prior to sailing we will contact to confirm the embarkation time.

Getting to the Marina

From Athens International Airport

By bus

Just outside the arrivals exit you will find the white and blue buses that take you to Athens. For Alimos Marina take the X96 with direction to Piraeus and get off at the stop "EDEM" which is just at the west entrance of Alimos Marina. Tickets can be bought at the ticket booth just next to the bus stop at the airport and prices are: 6,00 EUR adults, 3,00 EUR kids between 7-18 and free for kids up to 6.

By taxi

At the arrivals exit you will see the taxi rank where you will always find a taxi available. Usually each taxi will take up to 3 passengers with luggage (or 4 without luggage) and the price is approximately 40,00 EUR (it depends on the traffic / time needed to reach the marina as it is calculated based on the taxi meter). The price for a taxi between 12am and 6am will be higher. Most taxis accept only cash so in doubt ask before entering.

By Minivan

Minivans can take up to 8 passengers plus luggage and are booked via CV Yachts prior to arrival, the driver waits for you with a sign with your name on it and drives you directly to the yacht. The price for a minivan one way is 90,00 EUR (130,00 EUR from 12am to 6am).

By car:

There is parking in the marina next to pier 2 and pier 4 where you can leave your car. Parking is free but there is no surveillance.

√ Arriving early?

Do not spend the day waiting in the marina, take advantage of the day and visit the sites in Athens until your yacht is ready (you can leave your bags for free at our base)

√ Arriving late?

If you are arriving after 7pm, we will be waiting for you to give you the keys of the boat and do the paperwork, check in will take place the next day in the morning

When Arriving the following steps are followed:

Sign Charter Party When arriving at the marina we go through the charter party agreement, sign it and check that all the details on the crew list are correct. If this is not sent to us beforehand, we will need a copy of the skipper sailing license.

Refundable Security Deposit You are required to provide upon embarkation the amount of the deposit as specified by the contract according to the yacht that has been booked. This can be provided either in cash or via a valid credit card (CV Yachts accepts VISA and Mastercard). Upon disembarkation and inspection of the yacht by CV Yachts the amount of the deposit is returned (unblocked from credit card in case of use of card). The amount of the deposit specifies the amount you are liable for damages.

Settle Insurance Deposit

Damage Waiver You are required to provide upon embarkation, as specified by the contract, a non-refundable amount plus the amount of €650 which is refundable upon disembarkation. This can be provided either in cash or via a valid credit card (CV Yachts accepts VISA and Mastercard). Upon disembarkation and inspection of the yacht by CV Yachts the amount of the refundable deposit is returned to you (unblocked from credit card in case of use of card). In this case the non-refundable waiver is paid so that the amount of the liability in case of damage is only €650. For skippered / crewed charters Damage Waiver is obligatory.

Pay Mandatory Extras

You will need to pay the mandatory extras as specified in the charter contract. Payments of the mandatory extras are received at base in cash or via bank transfer together with the charter fee.

Refueling

There is no refueling station at the marina, once returning to the marina after your holiday the refueling truck will come to the pier and refuel the yacht.
For the refueling of the outboard jerrycan you will need to either go to the petrol station at the west entrance of the marina or leave this to CV Yachts (10 EUR charge)

Things to do in the area

Visit the Acropolis

The greatest and finest sanctuary of ancient Athens, dedicated primarily to its patron, the goddess Athena, dominates the centre of the modern city from the rocky crag known as the Acropolis.

Take a taxi or bus to the centre of Athens

Tickets: 20,00 EUR

The Acropolis Museum is an archaeological museum focused on the findings of the archaeological site of the Acropolis of Athens.

Visit the Acropolis Museum

Opening hours:
Monday 08:00 – 16:00 (last admission 15:30)
Tuesday to Sunday 08:00 – 20:00 (last admission 19:30)
Friday 08:00 – 22:00 (last admission 21:30)

Take a taxi or bus to the centre of Athens

Tickets: 10,00 EUR

Either go the centre of Athens and walk down Ermou street with all the high-street brands

Go shopping

or
Visit the nearest shopping centre, Athens Metro Mall, which is airconditioned and relaxing for shopping during the summer months

Take a taxi or bus to the centre of Athens or taxi to Athens Metro Mall

Go out at night

Visit one of the most elegant districts of Athens, Glyfada stands out for its sandy palm-fringed beaches, its cosmopolitan clubs (where the pulse of the Athens nightlife beats), its polished hotels, boutiques and restaurants

Take a taxi or bus

Extra tip: if you are a golf enthusiast you will be thrilled with the Glyfada Golf Club, the city's modern 18-hole course

Relax at the beach

Go to Vouliagmeni Beach and relax between the palm trees in this fully organized and cosmopolitan beach

Saronic Islands

Aegina, Agistri, Spetses, Hydra, Poros, Salamina and the peninsula of Methana form the island complex of the Saronic Gulf in southern Greece. Cyclades Islands

The most famous island group in the Aegean Sea comprises some of the most beautiful islands in the world! Gorgeous sandy beaches, architecture in white and blue, traditional lifestyle, folk music, warm, hospitable people and barren landscapes with isolated chapels turn a trip to the Cyclades into a lifetime experience.
