


MARINA DI STABIA

The tourist harbour of Marina di Stabia is one of the largest in Europe, located in Castellammare di Stabia, in the centre of the Gulf of Naples.

Check-in: Boarding on Saturday at 5 p.m.

Check-out: Return to the port on Friday by 4 p.m. to refuel
 (the fuel station closes at 6.30 p.m. In high season there may be queues)
 Disembarking on Saturday at 8 a.m.

Upon arrival at the harbour dock, the port staff will board for check-out. **

Deposit: To be paid upon boarding by credit card (Visa or Mastercard)
 € 2.500: Dufour 470 / Oceanis 46.1 or € 500.00 by paying € 270.00
 € 3.000: Dufour 530 / Oceanis 51.1 or € 750.00 by paying € 300.00
 € 4.000: Bali 4.2 / Bali 4.6 or € 850.00 by paying € 400.00

The deposit will be returned at check out

Parking: There are several parking spaces at the marina reserved for charters, so no need to book in advance. You will receive a parking ticket at the entrance, which you should keep. The parking fee is € 70,00 per week, payable directly at the automatic cash machine.

Food supply: Around the marina there are several supermarkets (Eurospin, Lidl, etc.) and shops selling local products.

The Deco' supermarket offers a free transfer service from the port to the supermarket and return.


You can request this service at check-in.

It also offers a delivery service for shopping on board.

You need to fill in a shopping list and pay directly in cash on delivery.




In the Marine Protected Area there are four zones where it is forbidden to enter, the two zones A of integral reserve and the two zones B.n.t. dedicated exclusively to sport diving. For the other zones, B, C and D, there are special regulations for boating, fishing and water activities. All these activities are regulated, even if not included in the scheme, and a permit is required to practice them.



In order to enter the protected area, you will need a permit and pay a fee of 20€ per week. Our harbour staff will be at your disposal to apply for the permit, which can be paid by credit card (Visa and Mastercard).
