How to reach Lefkas Nydri base:

Lefkas island does not have an airport, the nearest is the airport of Preveza (Aktio airport) and is located 38km from our base. You may also reach Lefkas island from Italy by ferry to Igoumenitsa.

By public bus from Athens: There are 4 buses daily for Lefkas island. The trip lasts approx 6 hours.

By taxi: You can find easily taxis at Aktio airport and at the port of Igoumenitsa.

Transfers (upon request): Athenian Yachts could arrange a transfer by minibus (up to 17 pax) or by taxi. You should require your transfer at least 7 days before your arrival.

Parking area: Car parking for the guests can be arranged under the instructions of our base staff.

Provisions service:

There are several shops and groceries around Lefkas base. Your provisions can be also organized by the Athenian team. (Upon request at least 5 days before your arrival) Your order will be on board upon your arrival. Opening hours for the super market: Daily open: 08:30 am—9:00 pm

Bank Transactions: All your pre-ordered extra service payments can be paid by credit card (VISA/MASTER) or in cash. There are an ATM in Nydri Village, 10 minutes walking distance from our base.

Fuel/Electricity: Upon delivery of the boat, the fuel tanks will be full. The floating piers in the base are equipped with 220 V pilars.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURES

Our base staff will require from the Skipper & Co-Skipper to attend the check-in procedure which contains the port police formalities and documentation procedure, the yacht technical demonstration and the inspection of the inventory list.

Port police formalities and documentation procedure

Starting the check-in you will be required to sign the charter documents for the port authorities (charter contracts, crew list form) and conclude any payments (i.e extra services, security deposit or damage waiver)

Early embarkation

The contractual embarkation time is at 17:00, the boat will be ready and clean. In the event that you wish to embark earlier you should require it at least 5 days before your embarkation. (Service provided with an extra cost)

Late arrival

Our base staff remain at the base up to 21:00 pm. In the event that your flight arrives later or due to a flight delay, the boat will be open and you may find the keys in the chart table. Check-in will take place next morning at aprox 09:00 am. For any problem you may face our base manager will be available at his mobile.

The yacht should return to the base, a day before the end of the charter , latest by 16:00- 17.00. **see page 1
Help us be ready to assist you, please advise our Base Manager of your **expected arrival time to base, in advance**. (Tel call or a text message)

There is a fuel station at **Perigiali**, approximately 1 nautical mile from our base in Nidri. It is recommended that you fill up your fuel tanks before your return, as there is no fuel tank at your base.

If during your trip you have noticed any sort of problem of the yacht we would be very grateful if you could notice it to our staff.

During check-out you are kindly asked to allow our staff to come aboard and inspect the yacht and her equipment. This inspection is very important , as we need to assure that the yacht will be in perfect condition, not missing inventory item, for the next clients chartering her after you.

After every charter, the yacht is also inspected underwater by a diver to ensure so as to avoid any inconvenience.

This is your last night on board and we hope that you enjoyed your sailing trip. At 09:00 next morning is your departure time from the boat. This will be a big help and ensure the yacht is ready in time for new arrivals.

Where possible, please leave the yacht as you find it! Kitchen items should be washed, dried and putted away. Left the dirty linen on the floor and the clean linen placed on beds. Please remove and dispose of the rubbish into the bins provided on the port. Life jackets and blanket left on beds.
