Procedures and formalities

Boarding procedures

14:00. – This is the time when the boat will be available for your boarding.

Reception, formalities, and navigation instructions will be provided on board by our base manager Dereck. Upon your arrival, we'll offer suggestions for sightseeing, authorized mooring spots, beaches, bars, and restaurants upon request.

Formalities / Deposit

A security deposit of **3,000 EUR** is required, payable by card or cash to the Base Manager at the time of boarding.

Bedding and Cleaning Fees

We supply bed linen and towels including sheets, pillowcases, and bath towels. We kindly ask that you return the boat in a tidy state, with dishes done and trash emptied.

* Charter Area includes only the area of Seychelles jurisdiction.

Technical Assistance

For any technical issues, please contact our Base Manager, Dereck, for assistance.

Skippered Rental

The skipper will manage all navigation and technical operations of the boat and will be responsible for any damage incurred as part of their services. The Charterer retains legal custody of the vessel and remains liable for any damage caused by the boat's use.

In Case of Damage


Any damage must be reported to the base manager immediately to notify the boat's insurer and take appropriate actions. The skipper is responsible for submitting a detailed sea report. Per the rental contract, the Charterer will assume the legal responsibilities regarding the skipper and certifies their ability to manage the boat or delegate that responsibility to the skipper.

Disembarkation Process

17: 00 on Friday with overnight on board in the marina till Saturday 09 a.m. on the final rental day – The boat must be returned by this time, moored, cleaned, and ready for inspection.

Return Inspection

Upon your return to port, a thorough technical inspection will be conducted, including checks of the hull, keel bolts, engine mounts, rigging, and other critical components. An underwater inspection will also be performed to ensure there has been no grounding.



The Company will provide the yacht and dingy boat with full fuel tanks before the charter.


After the charter, the yacht and dingy boat must be refilled fully by the Charterer, and the receipt must be shown to the Company representative at the end of the charter.

Mahé Sainte Anne Marine Park

Every day from **8:30** a.m. to **5** p.m.
200 rps per person per day and **250 rps** per morning per night. Pos or online payment only.

Bay Ternay Marine National Park

Every day from **8:30** a.m. to **5** p.m.
200 rps per person per day and **250 rps** per morning per night. Pos or online payment only.

Port launay Marine park

only mooring fee of **250 rps per day**.
Pos or online payment only

Curieuse and ste Pierre island

300 rps per day and **250 rps** per mooring is **250 rps per night**. Pos or online payment only/.

Aride island

entry fee is **600 rps per person**.
Its a guided island tour visit. No night anchorage at Aride island. Cash payment

Cousin island

the entry fee is **600 rps per person**. Its a guided tour, start at **10a.m to 12 noon**. No night anchorage at cousin island. Cash payment

Bird island

Entry fee is **50 euros per person** per day * Bareboaters not allowed to go there* Cash payment

Big sister (private island)

Entry fee is **600 rps 10 a.m to 3 p.m**

beach access only

Silhouette island

entry fee is **25 usd per person per day**, entry permission must be made and paid by the company before charter starts. Payments made to charter company in advance.

Vallee de mai on praslin

Entry fee is **450 rps** Pos or cash payment only

Fond Ferdinand national park

Entry fee is **300 rps per person**. Pos or cash payment only

La digue

Entrance fee to l' union estate - **150 rps per person**



January to June North Monsoon



7 days inner islands charter

- Day 1** Embarkation at 1400hrs at **Eden island Marina**, Either stay at Marina or spend first night at the Anne Marine Park.
- Day 2** Sail to **Praslin**, destination to **Anse Lafarine** for the rest of the afternoon and night.
- Day 3** Sail to **Curieuse Island** to see the Giant land tortoise, do the trail and visit the doctors house. Also **Ste Pierre islette** for snorkelling (wind dependent).

Sleep at **Curieuse Bay**.
- Day 4** Visit the UNESCO world heritage site **Garden of Eden**. Either **Vallée de Mai** or **Fond ferdinand**, and if guest wish to do **Anse lazio beach**. Must take a taxi as that area is not calm for boating.
- Day 5** **BIG sister island, Coco** and **felicité island** for snorkelling with various fish and also the possibility of swimming with sea turtles.
- Day 6** **La digue island**. After breakfast guest takes a bicycle, and go to discover the island. (full day)

Weather depending (.**behind ladigue. Anse Cocos, Petite Anse beach**) Sail down to see **Anne Marine park**.

1600hrs . Fuel station for refill. Night at **Eden Island Marina**.

Early breakfast Disembarkation at 9 a.m (the next day)

July to December South Monsoon



7 days charter

- Day 1** Embarkation 1400hrs at **Eden island**. Sail along the northern coast line for anchorage at **beau-vallon Bay**.
- Day 2** After breakfast, set sail for **Praslin Island**. Destination to **Anse Lazio** where guest have lunch, spend the rest of the afternoon snorkelling, swimming, making most of the beach.
- Day 3** Navigate to **Curieuse island**. Afternoon snorkelling at **Ste pierre islette**.
- Day 4** Visit the **vallée de Mai** or **Fond Ferdinand** (guest choice). Back to boat, lunch swim and spend the night
- Day 5** **The Big Sister, Coco and felicity islands**. Snorkel with various fish and possibility of swimming with sea turtles.
- Day 6** **La digue island**. After breakfast, guest goes down, get a bike and explore the island on their own.
- Sail to the **Anne Marine park**.
Lunch, swim, snorkel.
- 1600hrs . Fuel station for refill. Night at **Eden Island Marina**.
- Early breakfast Disembarkation at 9 a.m (the next day)
