

■ Marina Guide

Cleopatra is a relatively new marina on the Aktion Peninsula. It accommodates 100 vessels up to 30m in length and a draft of up to 8m.

The marina is perfectly set up for the cruising sailor as there is a chandlery and mini market on site, so you can replenish depleted stocks and replace any broken equipment. There are also clean and modern toilets, showers and laundry facilities, so you can freshen up after days or weeks at sea. The fuel dock is located within the marina and available 24/7 so you can fill up and depart at any time.

For those planning a longer stay, there's the opportunity for a complete refit, thanks to the extensive boatyard, covering an area of 11 hectares, with a large dry storage area.

The travel lift has the capacity to hoist, launch and berth yachts up to 45m LOA, 10m beam, 5m draught and 300 tonnes. The list of the available services for the visiting yachts is extensive, from antifouling, to grit, sand and hydro blasting services and re-upholstering.

The technical department of the marina can repair or replace engines, generators, outboards and propellers.

Cleopatra has a great atmosphere, and lots of little touches, including the children's playground, add to its appeal to cruisers, particularly the many cruising families who sail the Ionian. The marina is easily accessible by sea and very well protected, both naturally and by the sea wall. Many cruisers use Cleopatra as their starting off point, having arrived into Aktion Airport, just 1.5km down the road.

■ Passage Planning

Cleopatra Marina is located on the Aktion Peninsula, in the heart of the Ionian region, and dividing the Ionian Sea and the Gulf of Amvrakikos.

If you're pressed for time and want to make the most of the area, then you could fly directly into Aktion Airport, situated just 1.5km away from the marina. It's just under four hours flight time from London.

If you have more time, then sailing in offers beautiful views and a relatively stress-free sailing experience. The marina is easily accessible. Arriving in from the west, across the Ionian Sea, this part of the coast is likely to first be identified by the planes arriving and departing into the airport, which is just down the road from the marina. If the afternoon breeze has any NW in it, this can kick up an awkward chop in the entrance channel and you also need to be wary of the strong current that generally flows out of the gulf of Amvrakikos. You'll also easily identify the ancient town of Preveza, on Epirus, across the water from the marina. The bustling fishing town overlooks the harbour and reaches right down to the water. You're almost certain to see lots of little fishing boats entering and leaving the harbour, as well as other cruising sailors who frequent these exquisite waters through the summer.

The general rule is follow the fairly steady stream of boats and you'll come across the marina on your starboard side. The channel leading to the marina is clearly marked. It's advisable to stay safely within the markers, as the approaches are shallow outside of the main channel. The marina breakwater sticks out into the channel so is easy to spot, and the entrance is marked by lights on the southwest corner and northeast entrance point.

Call VHF Ch 67, on arrival, and marina staff will talk you in and direct you to your berth. Entry to the marina is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week, although it is always a good idea to call ahead so staff are prepared.

If you're planning winter maintenance, then you're advised to book in advance as demand is high and spaces fill up fast, particularly during the summer months when the area is busy with tourists from northern Europe.



■ Private transfer

Larger groups of sailors usually find a group transfer by minibus more convenient, whilst others may prefer a private transfer instead of a common taxi. Should you require a Private Transfer, feel free to let us know in advance and we will provide you with quotes from reliable transfer service providers. Please keep in mind that the transfer cost will be slightly higher as the drivers calculate the ride towards the pick-up location as well as any potential delay and whether a night time tariff applies.

NOTE: in case of a late arrival our staff will wait for you until approximately 20.00 hrs at night. If your arrival is after 20:00 your yacht will be ready & unlocked for you. Aboard you will find a welcoming message providing you with basic instructions for your first night aboard. Should you face any difficulty or problem, do not hesitate to contact our Base Manager (available to assist you on a 24/7 basis). Check-in procedure will take place the next morning.

■ Check-in procedure

Check-in procedure has to be attended by and performed with Skipper & Co-Skipper only.

Formalities

Before you check-in, you will be handing over at Hermes Yachting Preveza base the documents required for check in and we will take care of formalities such as signing required documents, handing the yacht's formal documentation & concluding any pending payments (i.e. security deposit & any extras).

Inventory list inspection

You will be provided with an inventory list so you may check and confirm inventory delivered with the yacht.

Technical inspection

Yacht condition is checked with our staff who will demonstrate basic functional / operational features of the yacht and her equipment.

Security deposit

As stated in the booking terms & conditions please note that Security deposit is to be paid via Master or Visa credit card only, no debit cards or personal checks accepted.
