

South Adriatic

ACI marina Split lies in the south-western part of the city port, north of the Sustipan Peninsula. The long breakwater protects the marina from the southern winds and the sea. The Marina is open all year round.

Facilities

Reception desk with a shop with a rich selection of accessories from the exclusive ACI collection, ATM, two restaurants, a snack-bar, toilet facilities and toilet facilities for the disabled, a food store**, a laundry, a nautical equipment store, charter and boat selling agencies, a maintenance and repair shop, sail repair shop, a 10 t capacity crane, a 45 t capacity slipway, a dismasting needle, a yacht wash-up waste water treatment plant and a car-park area. The Marina has a WLAN Internet system. The nearest petrol station is located in front of the Marjan Hotel (100 m) and the border crossing open throughout the year is located in the town port.

** a small shop where you can buy some basic groceries (opening hours Monday-Saturday 08 am – 08 pm, Sunday 08 am – 3 pm) or a supermarket 1 km from the marina (opening hours Monday-Saturday 08 am – 09 pm, Sunday 08 am – 03 pm)

Connections

Split is well connected to the rest of the world via a road infrastructure (motorway), a railroad, and by yearly or seasonal ferry lines to Rijeka, Dubrovnik and the Central Dalmatian islands, as well as to Ancona, Pescara and Bari (via Dubrovnik) in Italy. The Split international airport is some 25 km faraway.

Approach

The landmarks seen while entering the city port are the prominent bell tower of the Cathedral of St. Domnius, Cape Sustipan and the Marjan Hill on the west. The wide entrance into the city port lies between the main breakwater, on the head of which is a green lighthouse (FI G 6s 11m 10M) and the ACI marina breakwater, an extension of Cape Sustipan, on which there is a red tower with red lighthouse (FI R 6s 9m 5M). The latitude and longitude of the green lighthouse on the main breakwater are 43°30,1' N 16°25,5' E. Inside the port, ACI marina Split is protected with another breakwater, the head of which is marked by a red lighthouse (FI R 2s 6m 3M). After rounding the breakwater head ACI marina Split is approached. Closer to the shore there are some reefs marked with a green buoy.
