After that your yacht is ready for loading crew baggage on board and departure. For your security, our sailors are ready to help you go out and go in the pier of marina for our responsibility. **Place of embarkation on board is ACI marina Trogir Pier T and V.**

We kindly recommend you to read the boat manual and overview the check in/out online on www.eurospectra.com before arriving at the Marina.

Disembarkation time 09:00h with obligation to come back to the marina the day before till 18h00 (15.05-01.09); 16h00 (01.09-15.05) . Check-out procedure of the yacht take place on Friday at 18h00 (15.05-01.09); 16h00 (01.09-15.05).

General Infrastructure of the base


All berths have water and power supply.

Marina facilities:

How to get at base

Trogir is well connected to the land road infrastructure - a new motorway to Zagreb. The distance between Trogir and the regional center Split is 30km. Split international airport is located only 10km south from Trogir. Zadar international airport is located 110km north from Trogir.



Deposit and payment are payable at the time of embarkation by Croatian currency or credit cards. Mastercard, VISA credit American, Diners cards are accepted.

In accordance with Article 4 Paragraph 3 of The Ordinance on Boats and Yachts (Official Gazette No. 27/05, 57/06, 80/07, 3/08 and 18/09) certificates issued by the competent authorities of other states that have concluded bilateral Memorandum of Understanding with Croatian Administration are recognized for operating Croatian flag boats and yachts as in the table below.

Currency

The official currency in Croatia is the kuna (1 kuna = 100 lipa). Foreign currency can be exchanged in banks, exchange offices, post offices and in the majority of tourist information offices, hotels and campsites.

Credit cards (Eurocard / Mastercard, Visa, American Express and Diners) are accepted in almost all hotels, marinas, restaurants, shops and cash machines.

It's probably best to buy Croatian currency in Croatia, as buying in other countries can be a poor deal with high fees. There are ATMs and exchange offices in most international airports.

Local - navigation taxes

Croatian Tourist Tax amounting to 10 HRK/person/day (approx. 1,35 EUR/person/day) payable in advance at embarkation and covering the entire stay onboard.

Children up to 12 years of age and disabled persons are not liable to payment of Croatian Tourist Tax.

Doctors-hospital

There are health facilities in Trogir but more serious cases are referred to the town of Split and the helicopter service between the islands and Split Hospital is excellent.

If you need dental or medical treatment, make sure you have the necessary documents with you, including your passport. In some cases you may need to pay a fee.
