Trogir-Seget is well connected to the land road infrastructure - a new motorway to Zagreb.

Split international airport is located only 10km south from Trogir-Seget.  
Zadar international airport is located 100km north from Trogir-Seget.

### Currency

The official currency in Croatia is the kuna (1 kuna = 100 lipa). Foreign currency can be exchanged in banks, exchange offices, post offices and in the majority of tourist information offices, hotels and campsites. Credit cards (Eurocard / Mastercard, Visa, American Express and Diners) are accepted in almost all hotels, marinas, restaurants, shops and cash machines.

It's probably best to buy Croatian currency in Croatia, as buying in other countries can be a poor deal with high fees. There are ATMs and exchange offices in most international airports.

### **Local - navigation taxes**



Croatian Tourist Tax amounting to 10 HRK/person/day (approx. 1,35 EUR/person/day) payable in advance at embarkation and covering the entire stay onboard.

Children up to 12 years of age and disabled persons are not liable to payment of Croatian Tourist Tax.
